Job Summary:

- Lead large IT projects, including the design and deployment of new IT systems and services
- Manage IT team, performing tasks such as annual planning and forecasting, recruiting, budgeting, and staff development
- Protects Rogue systems by defining access privileges, control structures, and resources.
- Implements security improvements by assessing current situation; evaluating trends; anticipating requirements.
- Help define IT infrastructure strategy, architecture, and processes
- Create, maintain, and recertify security policies and procedures
- Analyze business requirements by partnering with key stakeholders across the organization to develop solutions for IT needs
- Ensure compliance with all NIST 800-171/CMMC security controls by:
 - Lead senior management through the process of prioritizing POAMs required to address areas of non-compliance
 - Secure resources to execute on above POAMs
 - Ensure that Rogue status is updated in the Supplier Performance Risk System (SPRS)
 - Ensure continued compliance with controls
- Provide consultative services to business development and contracting efforts, as needed
- Keep abreast of the state-of-the-art in Commercial and DOD cybersecurity domains
- Ensure that all Rogue spacecraft, software, and programs are secure
- Participate in the assurance of physical security of Rogue physical assets
- Provide MS Office and Windows application support.
- Provide Windows & Linux server support and VMware support
- Ensure that all software undergoes proper cybersecurity vetting
- Ensure that all Rogue personnel undergo periodic cybersecurity training
